2 Seats will be allotted as per merit, according to results of Entrance Examination.

3 Prospectus/Application form fee and Processing fees:

3.1 **Prospectus & Application form fee ` 150/-** in the form of Demand Draft/ Pay order to be Drawn in favour of '**Director, AIIPMR**' Payable at Mumbai. **This fee needs to be paid when the candidate obtains the form in person or by post**

3.2 **Processing fee ` 500/-** in the form of Demand Draft/ Pay order to be Drawn in favour of '**Director, AIIPMR**' Payable at Mumbai **along with application form.**

3.3 **For SC/ST Candidates Processing fee relaxed to ` 400/-.**

3.4 **Combined Demand Draft can be accepted for Processing fee + Application form fee from candidates who are applying online and who are downloading the application forms from the website (` 500/400 +`150/-= ` 650/-/ ` 550/-).**

ii) On successful application the system would show the candidates status as "applied for" but only when the confirmation page is received along with D.D. would the status change to "successfully applied"
