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# All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Mumbai

## Historical Background:

The institute was established in November 1955 as a Pilot Project of Govt. of India, Govt. of Bombay and United Nations Organisation, with technical expertise and manpower support from U.N.O. It came under the administrative control of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India in October, 1961.

Later the institute also became the pioneer institute in India for manpower development in the allied rehabilitation field of Prosthetics and Orthotics.

**Vision:** To be and remain a national and international leader in medical rehabilitation services, training and research and actualize the functional potential of every person with locomotor disability.

**Mission:** To optimally enable persons with locomotor disability with quality interventions, provide quality training to manpower and focus on the research that can help in better rehabilitation.

## Objectives:

- To create and provide comprehensive medical rehabilitation services for all categories of neuro-musculo- skeletal disorders including chronic disorders.
- To create and provide services through interdisciplinary approach with emphasis on disability prevention and rehabilitation.
- To train rehabilitation professionals through short term orientation courses and long-term graduate and post graduate courses.
- To train health functionaries at community level.
- Fabrication of aids and appliances.
- To conduct research in the field of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation.



## **Functions of the institute**

I. **To provide medical rehabilitation Services** to persons with temporary or permanent disability, in particular locomotor disability. In addition, the institute provides services for prevention and treatment of disabling conditions on outdoor as well as indoor basis.

The institute has indoor facility of 55 beds and surgical facilities for surgical rehabilitation.

Departments for comprehensive rehabilitation of the patients: Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Anaesthesia, Radio-diagnosis, Pathology, Physiotherapy, Occupational therapy, Prosthetics and Orthotics, Speech therapy, Vocational counselling, Medical Social work.

II. **Manpower development** in the field of medical rehabilitation by conducting various long term and short- term courses.

III. **Research** in the field of Physical medicine and Rehabilitation and allied rehabilitation fields.

IV. **Outreach activities** in Mumbai and other districts of Maharashtra. Sometimes extended to other states as well.

## 7 SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM:

### For MPO course:-

- 7.1 Duly filled application form along with admit card for MPO course only (in duplicate), Application fees and required self-attested certificates as mentioned in the application form can be submitted in room no. 201, 2nd floor/can be sent by post on Institute's address so as to reach on or before **14/11/2022** for **MPO**.
- 7.2 A candidate who is undergoing rotating internship and who is likely to complete the same by 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022 can appear for MPO CET-2022. Such a candidate will have to submit the documentary proof, from the Principal/Dean of the present college regarding the date of completion of internship along with the application form.

### For BPO Course:-

- 7.3 Duly filled in application form along with current year (2022-23) NEET Score Mark sheet, Class XII Mark sheet certificates and DD can be sent by post on Institute's address or can be submitted personally in the Institute.
- 7.4 Incomplete application form/application form received after last date of submission will be rejected and no fees will be returned under any circumstances and no communication in this regard will be entertained.
- 7.5 Photograph on the application form and on the admit card should be same and taken within last six months.
- 7.6 In case of personal submission and if candidate requires acknowledgment of submission of application form he /she should bring a photocopy of filled application form on which acknowledgement will be provided.

8.3 Candidates are supposed to apply for refund of deposits along with the original Fee receipt, immediately after the completion of course, else the amount of refundable Deposits will be forfeited.

### 8.5 **SUBMISSION OF SURETY BOND**

Candidates admitted for M.P.O. Course will be compulsorily required to submit surety Bond of Rs. 100000/- (Rupees one lakh only) on Rs. 100/- stamp paper with Notary. Candidates will be required to pay Rs. 100000/- (Rupees one lakh only) for not completing the course or for cancellation of admission after the Cut-off date declared by MUHS, Nashik /DMER, Govt. of Maharashtra.



## 9. Cancellation of admission for BPO & MPO:

- 9.1 If a candidate cancels his/ her admission before the cut –off date (declared by MUHS, Nashik. / D.M.E.R., Government of Maharashtra) the security deposit of Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) will be forfeited as administration charges & rest of the fees will be refunded.
- 9.2 No refund of fees including deposits will be given if a candidate cancels his/her admission after the cut-off date i.e. admitted under All India Quota as well as under Maharashtra State Quota (Selected by DMER).
- 9.3 Admission will be cancelled on production of 'No-Dues' Certificate from the Librarian/ Head of the Department along with application.
- 9.4 Candidate has to apply in prescribed format for refundable deposits immediately after final examination / completion of the course.

## 11 Hostel:

- 11.1 The Institute has very limited hostel facility and allotment will be done by the Hostel Committee as per laid down criteria if vacancy exists. Due to space constraints, the students will have to be prepared for dormitory type accommodation. It is not insisted upon by the institute authorities for hostel stay and students are at liberty to make their own arrangement.

### **13 Number of seats available: Total 16 seats**

- 13.1 **08 seats are available for candidates from all over India including Maharashtra (All India Quota)**, who have passed their H.S.C.(10+ 2) or Equivalent Examination and who had appeared for NEET UG 2022 Examination, with minimum 50% Marks in PCB for general category candidates, 40% marks for SC/ST/OBC & 45% marks for PH category candidates. Selection of candidates under All India Quota will be done as per the NEET score of current academic year 2022-23. Candidates domiciled in the state of Maharashtra can also apply under this quota.
- Reservation roster as per Government of India guidelines will be maintained
- 13.2 **08 seats are for Candidates domiciled in the State of Maharashtra (Maharashtra state Quota)**, who have passed their H.S.C. (10 +2) Examination from Colleges/Schools from Maharashtra State and appeared for NEET UG 2022. Selection of candidates under Maharashtra State Quota will be done by Directorate of Medical Education and Research (DMER), Mumbai, Maharashtra. 14.2 Birth Certificate or SSC (Class X) or equivalent examination certificate with the date of birth clearly endorsed shall be a valid evidence.

14.3 Current year NEET Scores will be considered for admission to BPO course along with other qualification & qualifying examination codes as per NEET prospectus-2022. Those applications not accompanied by class XII mark sheet and NEET-2022 mark sheet will not be considered.

14.4 The candidate must be an Indian National.

14.5 Eligibility of the candidates admitted, is granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik and Institute takes no responsibility for the same. It is not assured by the Institute at the time of admission that University will grant eligibility to the candidate.

Reservation of roster as per Government of India guidelines will be maintained

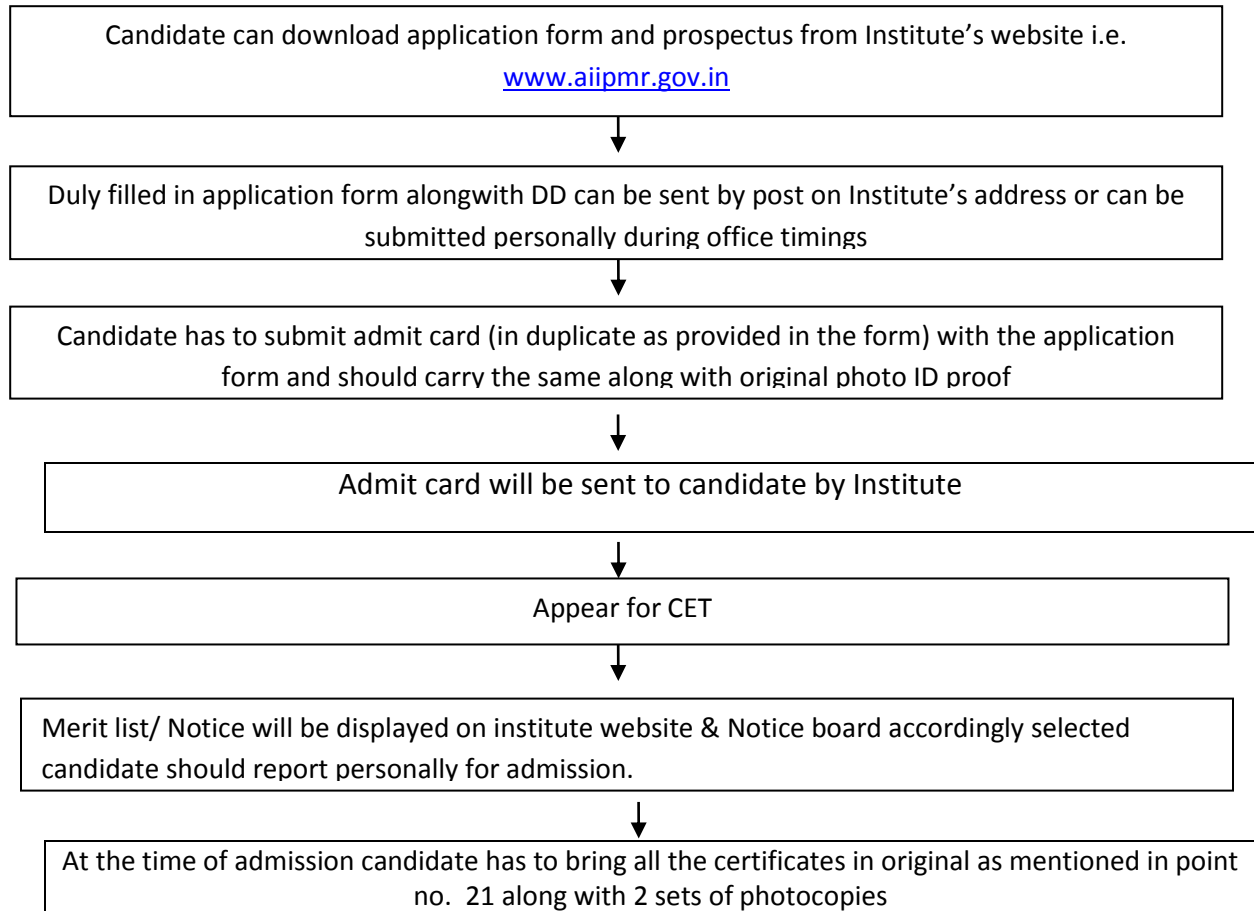

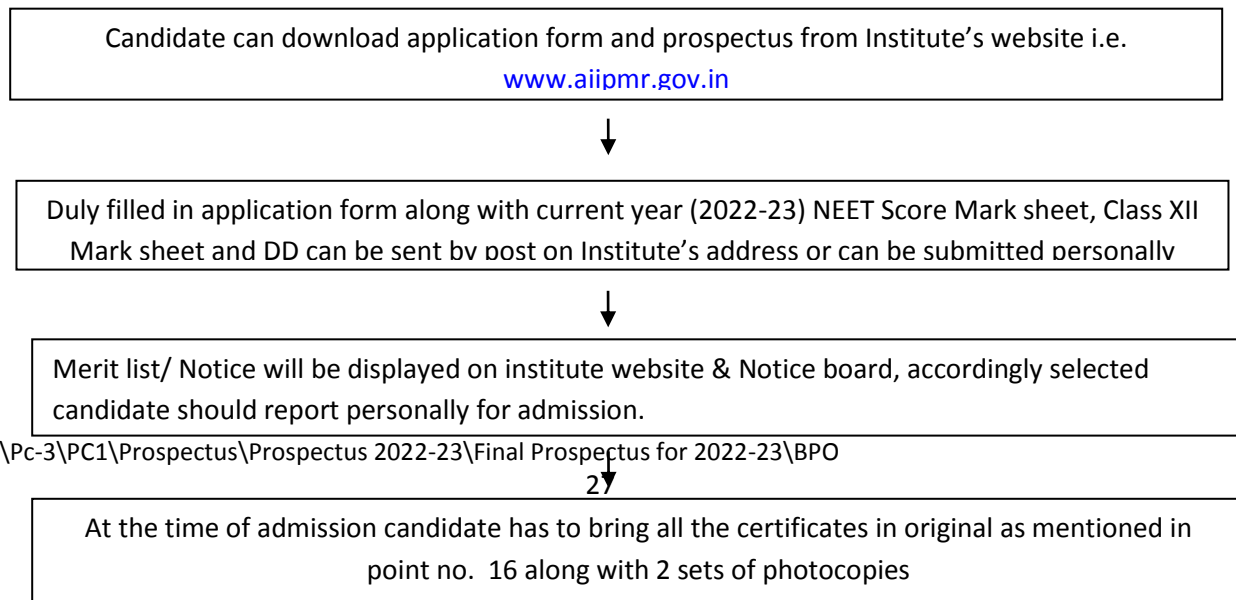
